The Summer Institute on the Empirical Implications of Theoretical Models (EITM) is designed for both graduate students and faculty. Familiarity with basic game theory and statistical concepts is essential. We intend to accept a pool of about 25 people for the program. **The application deadline for the June 2008 summer institute is February 15, 2008.**

Candidates interested in applying should submit the following:

- A curriculum vita with name, contact information, current location, and position
- A short, 1-2 page statement of why you would like to participate in the program
- A transcript (optional)
- 1 or 2 letters of endorsement (optional)
